To whom: Doctoral students of the University of Isfahan (UI)/Department of Civil Engineering.

Where to: Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV)/School of Civil Engineering.

Period of the stay in the UPV: 1st September 2024 to 2nd February 2025 // 1st February to 30th June 2025

What: Doctoral students will carry out a research project at the UPV as part of their doctoral thesis in the UPV's School of Civil Engineering.

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS:

PhD students from Department of Civil Engineering

APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED: BEFORE 25 December 2024 to Ms. Fariba Hadian (Erasmus+ Coordinator: isco3.ui@gmail.com) and Dr. Mehrdad Hejazi (International Coordinator of the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Transportation: m.hejazi@eng.ui.ac.ir).

The application should contain:

1. Academic record.
2. Personal CV in English.
3. English certificate: B2 or higher. (or equivalent Spanish language certificate)
4. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why she/he wishes to participate in this exchange.
5. Doctoral students must previously agree on the stay with the UPV professor who will supervise their research during the mobility. They shall present a document that refers to the research to be carried out at the UPV, with the approval of both the thesis supervisor and the UPV professor.
6. Completed scoring form provided by the home department in the UI.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

1. The GPA (up to 5 points);
2. English Certificate (B2 4 points, C1 4.5 points and C2 5 points)/or Equivalent Spanish Language Certificate;
3. The motivation letter (up to 5 points);
4. Applicant's CV (up to 5 points);
5. Scoring form provided by the home department (up to 15 points).
6. Approval from the home department confirming the applicant's eligibility for selection based on the department's internal regulations regarding the student's educational and research status, as well as the international activities and collaborations criteria for the applicant's supervisor.

The list of candidates with the scores obtained will be published [on this link](#) and on the Project website <https://icm2022.upv.es/>. The candidates will have one week to present the claims they deem appropriate to the selection committee.

After this period, the selection committee will resolve the claims, if any, and issue the final list of nominees and reserve list, [on this link](#) and on the Project website <https://icm2022.upv.es/>
